**NOTE:** This file identifies key Mormon Battalion participant journals, life histories, recollections and a few related documents. Original documents and transcriptions of original documents have been given preference in this list. It does NOT contain third and fourth hand repetitions of other documents. The colors help visually identify the Detachments and Return Groups. Not all journalists recorded all portions of their travels. For example, only three records of the Kearny Escort travels eastward are known - those made by Nathaniel Jones, Thomas Swords and Henry Turner.
